V. "I thirst". (John 19:28) As we continue our Life's journey, countless struggles of joys and pains came along with exhaustion of our might and vigor. We could never reach the greatest fulfillment of our goals without the supernatural graces of God. Our failures and frustrations made us thirst for the saving mercy and love of God.

May we seek first His Kingdom and His Righteousnes by educating ourselves in His WORDS through the Holy Scriptures, the beliefs and teachings of the Church, and in internalizing Christian Virtues so that we will become the best-version-of ouselves where being thirsty no more but a life fully human and fully alive.

I. "Father, **forgive** them, for they know not what they do". (Luke 23:34)

We focused on so much works for a superflous living and vainglory. The Sabbath Day is undermined and often not kept holy.

Many of us still don't believe in God nor care if He exists or not. Many failed to recognize God's very living presence in all His creations nor being grateful of His divine providence of love, mercy, and compassion to go on living this world. Many of us lack commitment to our Christian missions inscribed in the Sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation.

III. "Woman, behold thy son... Son, behold thy mother". (John 19:26-27)

VI. "It is Finished". (John 19:30)

Thus, we must live life righteously, joyfully, and productively. Let us make sure as much as possible that we have nothing to regret with the Lord, if Tomorrow never comes anymore.

Therefore, let us always be in good terms with others and in keeping good harmony with the universe. Humility polishes our finished works. Let us not miss the time and the opportunity nor undermind the need to go on Confession or have the Sacrament of Reconciliation to obtain peace and confidence for the good quality of the works and deeds that we finished here on earth.

II. "Amen, I say to thee, this day thou shalt be with Me in **paradise**." (Luke 23:43)

We lack enough courage and fidelity to stand on the multitude of humankind to proclaim the divinity and humanity of the Lord. But God remain faithful and true to His promise. He is life and love.

May we resolve to set a special time to meet Him in "Paradise" – in the Daily Holy Eucharist and in the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Practically, He is in our Home – our Family Paradise.

VII. Father, into Your Hands I commend my spirit. (Luke 23:46)

When our mission is accomplished, we can humbly commend to God our spirit.
