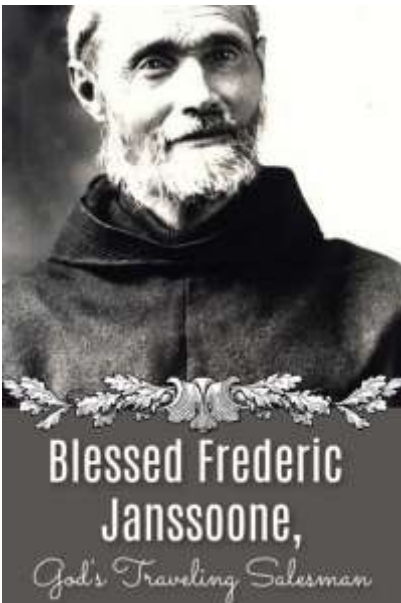

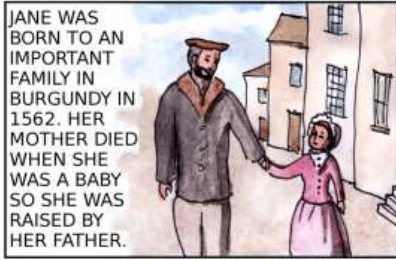
BLESSED FATHER FREDERIC JANSOONE O.F.M. – BEATIFICATION:



Father Frederic Janssoone, a Franciscan friar was born on November 19 th , 1838, in Guyvelde, in the Flemish flatlands of northern France. He entered the Franciscan Order and was ordained on August 17, 1870. He was in the Holy Land for twelve years where he served ten years as Custos or the Franciscan Superior of the Holy Land. Starting in 1888 he established a commissariat of the Holy Land in Trois-Rivières and became the first director of pilgrimages at Our Lady of the Cap Shrine. A remarkable preacher and a prolific writer, he spread the devotion to Our Lady of the Cape and to the Passion of Our Lord throughout the province of Quebec and established the Third Order of St. Francis. After earning the reputation of being a saint, he died in Montreal on August 4 th , 1916. His body rests at 860 St-Maurice Street in Trois-Rivières. Pope John Paul II declared him blessed on September 25 th , 1988, one hundred years following his witnessing of the opening of the eyes of the statue of Our Lady of the Cape.

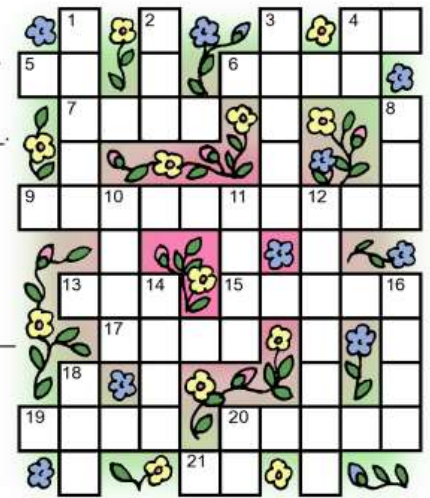

The preparation for confirmation aims to lead the Christian toward more intimate union with Christ. Preparation for Confirmation is open for children who are in Grade 7.
