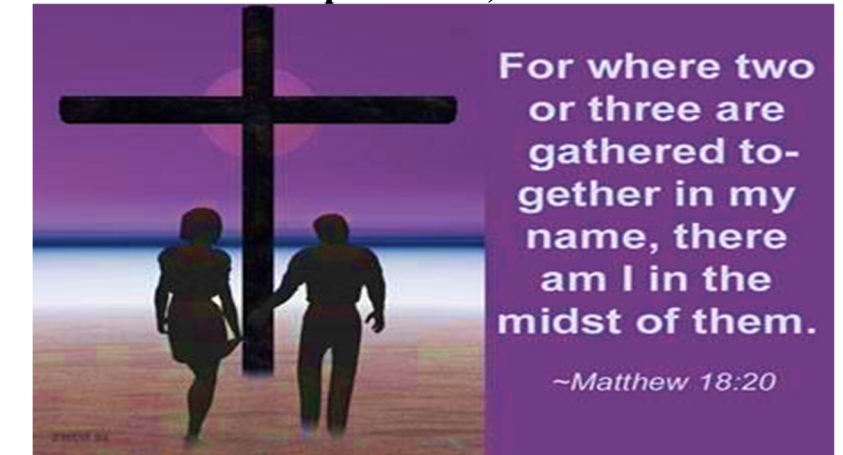

SACRED HEART'S HOLY MASS

CATHEDRAL RENOVATION

RECENT PROJECTS: The Mechanical System Description Report done in April, cost \$4,200. The Energy Efficiency Assessment done in June, cost \$10,200. The new PA system in August, cost \$14,000.

The PRO argument: 40% of this work can be subsidized by the Government until March 2022. The AGM in March 2020 approved this work. There was a Schematic Design Report in April 2020. An Energy Efficiency Assessment was completed in June 2020. There may be Community Development Funding available.

The parish does have funds in a long-term account, but the interest paid on this is smaller than the saving resulting from the renovation. Inflation due to COVID 19 is causing the purchasing power of the account to shrink. The cost of energy (*heating oil and electricity*) is increasing. The cost of the renovation work and materials will increase.

The CON argument: We do not have enough money for the whole project. And we are unlikely to improve that position as with COVID19 fewer people come to church; there are fewer rentals of the hall. Revenue from rentals and donations has decreased.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY ASSESSMENT (EEA): ASHRAE Level 2 Energy Audit. This audit is on the front page of our website for everyone to read. Sacred Heart Cathedral has now received the final energy audit with the requested revisions and changes. **Without this assessment Sacred Heart Parish cannot apply for the 40% rebate from the Government. The assessment cost was \$10,158.75.**

Recommendations from the EEA:

Now we use 163 MWh of energy per year (\$17,806). After the renovations, we will need 82 MWh (\$8,903). **We can reduce the energy usage (50%) by:** (*if we install Solar PV even more, and our bill will be \$6,822*).

- **Add wall insulation:**
Cathedral now R 14 City requirement R 28
Basement now R 6.8 City requirement R 28
Reduce energy usage to 14.44% saving \$2,571.
- **Windows upgrade:**
now R 2 after R 4.9
Reduce the energy usage to 12.60% saving \$2,245.
- **Furnace & HRV:**
Reduce the energy usage 15.78%. saving \$2,820.
- **Add the lower sloped roof insulation** (*above the elevator, meeting room and sacristy*):
lower roof now R 11.5 City requirement R 60
Reduce the energy usage to 2.40% saving \$429

NEW WINDOWS. We have three options available to Sacred Heart Cathedral (upstairs):

Option A: repair existing frames and old colored glass. We could sandwich the existing colored glass between two panels of clear glass creating an argon filled triple paned sealed unit. (*One unit has already been made. If you wish to see what it would look like the second window on the left of the altar in the cathedral has been done.*) This option will cost \$49,024 plus gst. **(Parish \$29,400 Government \$19,600)**

Option B: new vinyl frames and old colored glass. The colored glass will then be used to construct a new triple pane unit that will be installed into a window and reinstalled into the opening. The vinyl frames will be coated/painted on

the exterior to match similar dark brown finish of exterior trim. The interior of the vinyl window will be beige and blend into the existing wood finish within the Cathedral. This option will cost \$82,508 plus gst. **(Parish \$49,500 Government \$33,000)**

Option C: new vinyl frame with Bronze Solar Cool glazing to outer surfaces to reduce the amount of sun coming in. The very bottom windows (36") will be insulated and covered with cedar in the interior (*to match the ceiling*) and brown metal on the exterior to match the exterior. The interior of the vinyl window will be beige and blend into the existing wood finish within the Cathedral. This option will cost \$87,000 plus gst. **(Parish \$52,000 Government \$34,800)**

How can we pay for new windows?

- **40% from Government.**
- **60% from our Parish (Benefactor Program) or we use Long Term Deposit.**

Please remember that the windows are only the beginning! We already collect \$3,850. Our goal for windows is: \$50,000. Price for one window is \$4545. (after Government rebate)

SPECIAL REQUEST PRAYER: You are all familiar with our need for structure renovations in the Cathedral. **We are hoping soon to address the need to upgrade our windows before winter. This would greatly diminish the load on the furnace which is already nearing the end of its life expectancy.** Over the years on the windows stop-gap measures were employed to 'buy time' until this major work could be undertaken.
