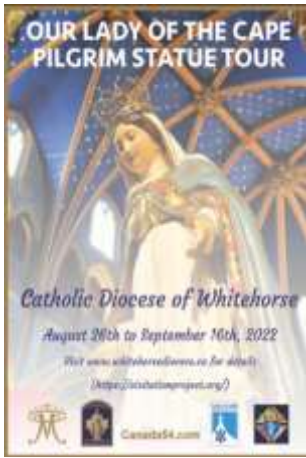

PAPAL VISIT TO CANADA

The Vatican has released additional details regarding the Papal Visit to Canada, July 24-29, 2022 (Press release 23.06.2022). The Pope's visit will provide an opportunity for him to listen and dialogue with Indigenous Peoples, to express his heartfelt closeness and to address the impact of residential schools in Canada. The papal visit will also provide an opportunity for the shepherd of the world's 1.2 billion Catholics to connect with the Catholic community in Canada. The

Holy Father will travel within Alberta (based in Edmonton) from July 24-27, followed by a visit to Quebec City and Ste. Anne-de-Beaupré, July 27-29. Pope Francis will visit Iqaluit, Nunavut the afternoon of July 29 before returning to Rome. Drawing on the theme, "Walking Together", the Holy Father's journey of reconciliation, healing and hope includes visits to a former residential school, Indigenous pilgrimage sites, two public Masses and a mix of private and public events. As Edmonton is the closest hub to our diocese, that program is posted below. There will be tickets available (free) for a limited number of events, all of which will be broadcast and accessible via livestream. All Catholic faithful in Canada are encouraged to participate as fully as they can whether they attend the events in-person, or through prayer, fasting, and online viewing. Volunteer opportunities are also available at the events and virtually. For ticket information, to volunteer, donate or learn more, visit www.papalvisit.ca. You can also read the Catholic Bishops' news release welcoming this announcement from the Vatican. We are grateful to God for this visit from Our Holy Father. Please continue to pray for the health of Pope Francis and for all those engaged in the ongoing healing and reconciliation journey.



OUR LADY OF THE CAPE PILGRIM STATUE TOUR

Most Rev. Héctor Vila is pleased to announce the visit of Our Lady of the Cape to the Diocese of Whitehorse. This three-week pilgrim statue tour will take place at the end of the summer from August 26th to September 16th, 2022. This year marks the 75th Anniversary of the Consecration of Canada to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. These Marian tours are happening this year in various dioceses across Canada to provide opportunities to venerate Canada's National Madonna and to promote the on-going consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The last time the statue visited our diocese was in 1953. Once again, we are blessed to have this occasion for renewal, healing and unity within our diocese through the intercession of our Blessed Mother Mary. Some events will begin in mid-August with public screenings of the film Bridge of Roses: The Story of Our Lady of the Cape in each parish and mission. This will be followed by activities in individual communities throughout our diocese, in the Catholic schools in Whitehorse, and other locations. APARTMENT NEEDED FOR A REFUGEE FAMILY!

Yukon Cares sponsors refugees who are fleeing from war, violence or persecution to re-settle in Whitehorse. The family that we are sponsoring has been waiting for years to come to safety in Canada. They have been thoroughly vetted by the Canadian government, and they are very excited to start their new lives in Canada. This family is a father and his 8-year-old son from Pakistan. The father speaks English and Urdu. They were sponsored by Project Hope, which is a project of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Toronto. Project Hope raised money to sponsor 100 refugee families, and asked Yukon Cares to resettle this small family in the Yukon. We have worked closely with the Archdiocese of Toronto for several years, and we were happy to help out!

- How Yukon Cares supports the landlord and tenants
- We pay the damage deposit, as well as the first year of rent
 - We teach each family how to care for, clean, and maintain all parts of a Canadian home.
 - We clean with the family for the first few weeks, to make sure they understand how the house is to be maintained.
 - We have translators available to help with any translation issues that arise, and volunteers available to help if the family has any concerns about how things work in the house.

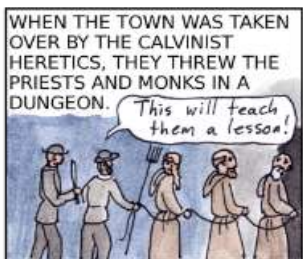
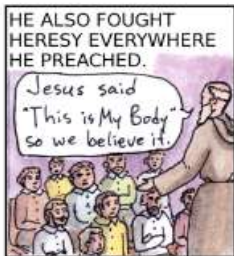
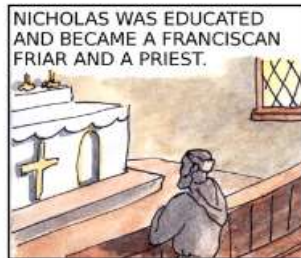
