

CATHOLIC BISHOPS OF CANADA INVITE ALL CANADIAN FAITHFUL TO JOIN POPE FRANCIS AND TO PRAY FOR PEACE

17 March 2022 – Ottawa – On Friday, 25 March 2022, Pope Francis will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary during the Celebration of Penance that he will preside over at 5:00 pm (Rome time), in St Peter's Basilica. Pope Francis wishes to place the people of Ukraine and Russia under the protection of Mary, the Mother of God, with a special liturgical act. To this end, he will consecrate the two countries to the Immaculate Heart of Mary at a penitential celebration. This act has been well received by the Catholic Bishops in Ukraine, as well as by the Russian Bishops. In response to Pope Francis' decision to consecrate both Ukraine and Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the Ukrainian Catholic leaders will prepare with a novena that will start on 17 March 2022. They hope that all Catholic faithful from around the world will join them. In view of this appeal, the Catholic Bishops of Canada, united with the Holy Father, invite their faithful and all people of good will to participate in the novena with the following prayer:



**God of peace and justice,
we pray for the people of Ukraine today.
We pray for peace and the laying down of weapons.
We pray for all those who fear for tomorrow,
that your Spirit of comfort would draw near to them.
We pray for those with power over war or peace,
for wisdom, discernment and compassion to guide their decisions.
Above all, we pray for all your precious children, at-risk and in fear,
that you would hold and protect them.
We pray in the name of Jesus, the Prince of Peace.
Amen.**





<p>SATURDAY MASS AT SACRED HEART CATHEDRAL</p> 	<p>Parishioners may be interested in knowing that Fr. Slawek says a Saturday morning Mass at 9 AM on the first two Sat. of each month. This is a relatively new arrangement. In the past when Maryhouse had the privilege of having one of their own Madonna House priests living with them, a Sat. morning Mass was celebrated at Maryhouse. Because space was somewhat a factor this Mass was limited to a group of friends who expressed interest in joining Maryhouse for this. When Maryhouse no longer had a resident priest Fr. Slawek graciously agreed to continue these Sat. Masses. With the onset of the pandemic and the resulting restrictions on gatherings this had to be temporarily curtailed. When we were again allowed to have smaller Masses it became obvious that families had grown in number and more people were interested in attending a Sat. Mass. The space at Maryhouse had become too small to accommodate the numbers and Fr. Slawek agreed to move the Mass to the Cathedral. So if you would like to attend a Saturday morning Mass (it does not satisfy the Sunday obligation) it will be held at Sacred Heart Cathedral on the first two Saturdays of each month at 9 AM.</p>





The 3rd Sunday in Lent - Some Musings

"A good tree cannot bear bad fruit"

Outside my windows the snowflakes are dancing, swirling in the wind, seeming to be carefree and full of the joy in their being. The wind is light and it's a joy to my heart as I watch. The trees out there are barren; the only colour is the deep, intense green of the pines and firs. It is a sight that does not inspire this heart. These simple pleasures, the trees, the breeze, all of creation are gifts to be cherished and not squandered by us. Many of the pine cones have fallen, to be picked up by the little critters who share my yard. So while foraging is difficult, the wise little creatures have stored away food to last through the long cold days of winter. I have a friendly little grey squirrel who occasionally comes calling at my patio door with a nut in his mouth! He knocks with that nut on my window pane. He looks for all the world as though he's asking me to open my door and assist him in that endeavor. In the late fall he was chubby and his fur was well cared for. I'll bet anything that this wise little fellow knows good fruit from bad fruit.

I wondered, as I prayed with this passage, what kind of fruit I bear. Like that fig tree, I often ask for one more chance to prove myself worthy to be called one of His disciples. God is very patient with us, giving us one more chance to grow more and more into His likeness. To become a worthy disciple takes more than just wishing it were so. It requires work on our part. Jesus knows our weaknesses. He has, after all, given us the Sacraments. When we fail, we have the Sacrament of Reconciliation to strength us; if we are ill, whether in soul, body or spirit we have the Sacrament of Healing; and to strengthen us on our daily paths, we have that marvelous Sacrament of the Eucharist. These Sacraments give us the food to strengthen us and keep us true to His ways. They help us to produce good fruit that will help us to build His Kingdom, to be a consoler, a model Christian for His glory.

We should examine our lives and, with His help, change what needs changing in our lives. Christianity is not a matter of a Sunday Mass observance but rather a way of life that He has called us to emulate. We are to love Him with our whole being and love others. Sound simple? Not really. Becoming a good disciple takes commitment to His teaching, reading the words He's left us and being diligent in following these teachings.

As I look at the barren trees behind me, I realize that sometimes I feel just like that - barren with little to give to anyone. That's when prayer becomes so very vital. And I realize then that prayer is a dialogue not a monologue. It is easy to become so engrossed in our prayer that we don't take time to listen. I call to mind Psalm 46 which tells us, "Be still and know that I am God." I recall a time when I was so focused on what I had to say that I wasn't listening. Then I seemed to hear a voice in my head saying, "Stop talking and just listen." This sudden epiphany reminded me that only in the silence of the heart can we hear the voice of our Lord. If we are to produce good fruit we need to listen. We've got two ears and one mouth, let's use them like that.

I live in a lovely, peaceful neighbourhood and I can listen to the sounds of the natural world. The other morning I saw my first robin of the coming spring. His red breast was in striking contrast to the white snow. It was my first glimpse of the hope of spring. Soon the trees will blossom, the grass will awaken from its snowy shroud and the activity around me will burst forth. Some of our bulbs and the nuts and pine cones, will feed the squirrels. Let's make sure that we bear good fruit, living lives that will help our newly baptized and confirmed see us as a model of His love, His compassion and His beneficence.
