2. SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION & CATECHISM CLASSES

A. Sacrament of Baptism

Under ideal situations, before the initiation of the Sacrament of Baptism, Parents and Godparents are required to attend the Pre-Baptism Classes every 1st and 2nd Friday of the Month at 7:00 - 8:00 PM in the Rectory. A Baptismal Form shall be duly accomplished and attach the Birth Certificate of the Child to be baptized.

Baptism Ceremony will be finally scheduled upon compliance of all the requirements. Usually, it will be at 6:00 PM of Saturday and 1:00 PM of Sunday respectively.

B. Sacrament of Reconciliation

Sacrament of Reconciliation is initiated Daily at an specified Day and Time. On a **Saturday** done at 4:00 – 4:45 PM or a call for an appointment. On a **Sunday it will be done** before the Mass while on a **Monday to Friday**, it will be at 11:30 AM – 12:00 NN or after the Holy Mass celebration. You may use the Confession Guide found at the vestibule.

C. Sacrament of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, Confirmation

Under normal situations, the initiation of the Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation, shall be preceded by a structured **Catechesis Classes of the Good Shepherd Program** in collaboration of the Christian Education and Development Apostolate of the Parish. Further, in cooperation of the parents and families of the children undergoing the sacramental preparations.

For the 2024 – 2025 Catechesis Classes, registration is now going on and all classes will start in October to be held at the Rectory. Parents are required to fill-up the corresponding Registration Form and submit with other documents required especially the Baptismal Certificate.

Volunteer Catechists are needed for the First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation classes. Training is provided. For further information please contact Caroline Knickle at csknickle@gmail.com.

D. Sacrament of Marriage

In customary conditions, **Marriage Preparation** is very vital and necessary before the initiation of the Sacrament of Marriage. The couples planning to receive the Sacrament of Matrimony shall **first visit the Church or the Rectory and seek guidance of the Rector or authorized persons on what to do**. They need to **fill-up the necessary forms** required with **utmost veracity**. Couples shall **complete attendance and participation** on the structured **Pre-Marriage Program** consisting of Six Major Themes. **Certificate of Completion** will be issued in order to proceed to the **next step** in Marriage Preparation.

Upon **faithful complete compliance** of the requirements, the **schedule** of the Wedding Ceremony shall be **finalized by the couple and the Priest or Rector** in their **mutual agreement**.

3. ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT – SUMMER SCHEDULE

Every Thursday after the **12:10 PM Holy Mass until – 2:00 PM only**. Devotees are highly encouraged to profess the **Litany of Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**. Please include the **Prayer Intentions offered in the Intention Box** and the **Pope's Intention for August** as follows: *"We pray that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick confer to those who receive it and their Loved ones the power of the Lord and become ever more a visible sign of compassion and hope for all."*

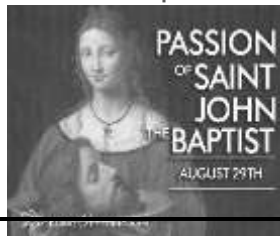

Cycle of Catechesis. The Spirit and the Bride. The Holy Spirit guides the people of God towards Jesus our hope. 6. “The Spirit of the Lord is upon me”. The Holy Spirit in the Baptism of Jesus

Summary of the Holy Father's words

Dear brothers and sisters:

In our continuing catechesis on the Holy Spirit, we now turn to the descent of the Spirit upon Jesus at his baptism in the Jordan. There, Jesus was revealed as the beloved Son of the Father and was anointed by the Holy Spirit at the beginning of his public ministry. As the Messiah, Priest, Prophet and King, Jesus in turn bestows the Spirit upon us, the members of his mystical Body, the Church. In Baptism, each of us is anointed with the perfumed oil of chrism as a sign of our sharing in Christ's life and our mission to spread the fragrance of his saving presence in our world. May we daily cultivate this anointing and serve to spread “the good odour of Christ” (2 Cor 2:15) in the lives of all whom we meet.
