




## PARISH MINISTRY

### HEALING & RECONCILIATION: AN HISTORIC JOURNEY

The Holy Father will travel within Alberta (based in Edmonton) from July 24-27, followed by a visit to Quebec City and Ste. Anne-de-Beaupré, July 27-29. Pope Francis will visit Iqaluit, Nunavut the afternoon of July 29 before returning to Rome.

Drawing on the theme, "Walking Together", the Holy Father's journey of reconciliation, healing and hope includes visits to a former residential school, Indigenous pilgrimage sites, two public Masses and a mix of private and public events. As Edmonton is the closest hub to our Diocese, that program is posted below. There will be tickets available (free) for a limited number of events, all of which will be broadcast and accessible via livestream. All Catholic faithful in Canada are encouraged to participate as fully as they can whether they attend the events in-person, or through prayer, fasting, and online viewing. 

### OUR LADY OF THE CAPE PILGRIM STATUE TOUR

Most Rev. Héctor Vila is pleased to announce the visit of Our Lady of the Cape to the Diocese of Whitehorse. This three-week pilgrim statue tour will take place from August 26th to September 16th, 2022. This year marks the 75th Anniversary of the Consecration of Canada to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. These Marian tours are happening this year in various dioceses across Canada to provide opportunities to venerate Canada's National Madonna and to promote the on-going consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The last time the statue visited our diocese was in 1953. Once again, we are blessed to have this occasion for renewal, healing and unity within our diocese through the intercession of our Blessed Mother Mary. Some events will begin in mid-August with public screenings of the film *Bridge of Roses: The Story of Our Lady of the Cape* in each parish and mission. This will be followed by activities in individual communities throughout our diocese, in the Catholic schools in Whitehorse, and other locations. JULY 21**






HE WAS A GREAT PREACHER AND TRAVELLED ALL OVER EUROPE.


EVEN THOUGH HIS LIFE WAS VERY BUSY HE WOULD ALWAYS TAKE TIME TO PRAY.




