



- 4. FORTITUDE** [also known as Courage]: strengthens our will so that we can actually accomplish what is true, good and beautiful.
- 5. KNOWLEDGE:** enables us to discover God's will in all things.
- 6. PIETY:** helps us to love God, our merciful Father, and to obey his precepts out of love for him.
- 7. FEAR OF THE LORD** [also known as Wonder and Awe]: helps us to understand how we must depend on God for everything. In other words, he is God, we are not.



## THE FEAST OF PENTECOST – SOME MUSINGS

As a child of about five, I was frightened by a roaring prairie fire. It raged over our section hill and was stopped only by our road. I can still recall the smell of burning grass and the smokey smell that clung to my Dad and uncle as they came in tired and sooty from fighting that fearful blaze. My mother and aunt tried desperately to calm the fears of my brother and sister, and my cousins. We didn't sleep much that night as Dad and Uncle Gene stayed awake to ensure the fire was truly out and our barns and cattle were safe. Fire is a fearful thing. While we didn't lock our doors in fear, Mom's apron felt like a real refuge. I have never had to lock my doors in fear like those early apostles, but I can understand their fear in that Upper Room, locked away for fear of the Jewish authorities. I have never had to lock myself away in fear for my safety but I am careful to keep the doors locked when I retire for the night. Nor have I ever been blessed with speaking many different languages without a good deal of study.

The feast of Pentecost heralds in two feasts that will end the Easter season and bring us once again to that long liturgical season of Ordinary Time. Ordinary Time is that time in which we live most of our lives. It's a liturgical season of course but it's also that time when we do many ordinary things. However, it's also that time in which we can make some significant changes to our faith practice; to improving our prayer life; to spending time developing a deeper relationship with our God and our neighbours.

So often we can think that these remarkable events only occur "back in Jesus' time", forgetting that when we were confirmed, we were given those same gifts of that same Holy Spirit. As St. Paul tells us in his first letter to the Corinthians, there are many gifts but the same spirit. And every confirmed Catholic has been gifted with a gift meant to be used to build up the Body of Christ. As we come to the end of the Easter season, let's take some time to assess our gifts and find ways to use them for that purpose. I think the ways in which each of us has been gifted in a different way is a bit like a jigsaw puzzle; once the gifts are all used in the manner in which they are intended, the world looks like a wonderful puzzle that brings peace, joy and comfort to all.

If we all had the same gifts, what a boring world this would be. The world would look like a blank easel on which nothing had been painted. But each of us is meant to use our special gifts to enhance the lives of those around us. How many of us can name all the gifts of the Holy Spirit given to each of us at Confirmation? We need to go back to the Catechism and refresh our memories. I'm not suggesting that just being able to name those gifts is a knowledge of how they are to be used but if we remember them in times when we should call on them to aid us in our roles as His disciples we can put them to good use.

Our Lord has given us a beautiful world to be a temporary home for us. The kindly breezes, the gentle rain and yes, even the fierce storms that sometimes trouble us add a variety to our lives. So as we come to the end of the Easter season and celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, let's thank God for all His many blessings and give Him glory in that long period of Ordinary Time.
