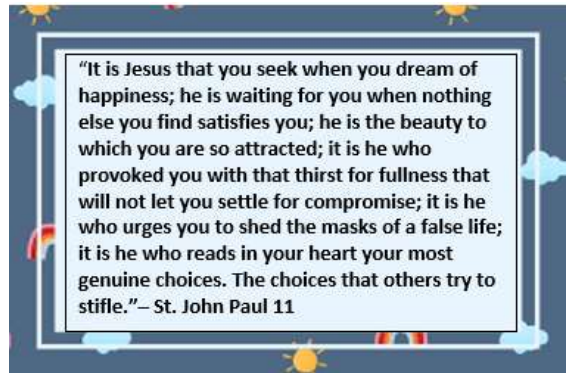


First Reading: Sirach 35.15-17,20-22

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

Sacred Heart Basement Insulation Retrofit Update

Winter is coming. Our Cathedral needs new boots and a parka!

The boots are the new insulation now being installed on the basement walls. The parka is the wall insulation that we hope to install next year.

We want to put insulation on the basement walls down to the footing of the Cathedral. We plan to add about 15 cm (6 inches) of insulation, which has an RSI value of 6.2 (R35). That work has started.

This is the first step. We don't know the price exactly, as there may be unexpected costs. However, our budget for the basement insulation is \$180,000. Fortunately, we have received \$56,250 from the Community Development Fund. We also expect to receive approximately \$70,000 from the Good Energy Program. Donations from parishioners to-date are \$39,000. The total of these contributions is \$165,250.

Our plan is to finish installing the new basement insulation this year. Next year, we hope that we can insulate the main floor walls and install a new heating and ventilation system and complete the main-floor walls insulation and mechanical work if we have enough funds.

Next year, 2023 is the last year that funding will be available from the Good Energy Program. To meet that goal, the architect is already working on the drawings for the Cathedral main-floor walls insulation retrofit.

Two concerns about the on-going project:

First, please don't worry that the big heating fuel tank is disconnected. We have already put in a smaller tank that will be used to supply heating fuel to the furnaces during construction. Secondly, please use only the front door during construction for your own safety. This will also help avoid bringing dust, dirt, and mud from the construction area into the Cathedral.

Your continuous support for this project is very much appreciated.
