



Our catechesis programs for children begin this week.




Confirmation classes for grade seven students will begin Monday evening in the CYO Hall from 6:30 to 8:00 pm.

Retrofit of Sacred Heart Cathedral update



SCH cathedral will soon be undergoing renovations to retrofit and insulate the foundation. This will help

extend the life of the Cathedral and improve heating costs.

The north, south and west side foundation will be retrofit from outside. The east wall will be retrofit from inside. For some of this construction time parishioners will not be able to access the cathedral through the north door. Use of CYO Hall will also be affected. This project will require us to disconnect the oil furnace. It's estimated this project will take between 2-3 weeks and be completed before winter.

The cost of the retrofit of the foundation is \$185,000 (Construction + Architect). Through the Government of Yukon Good Energy Program, we will receive approximately \$62,000 to cover the cost. This project has received an additional \$75,000 funding through the Community Development Fund grant.

In the spring, we will consider further upgrades to insulate the walls should we have the funds to do so.

We appreciate your donations for this important project extending the life of our cathedral.

Blessed Marie-Rose Durocher October 6



EULALIE DUROCHER WAS BORN IN 1811 IN A VILLAGE OUTSIDE OF MONTREAL IN CANADA. SHE WAS THE 10TH OF 11 CHILDREN.

AS A GIRL, EULALIE GOT A GOOD EDUCATION AND LIKED HORSES.

Here, buy! I brought you some apples!

SHE FELT CALLED TO THE RELIGIOUS LIFE BUT WAS TOO SICKLY TO JOIN THE CONVENT.

Oh, thank you.

SHE WAS KIND TO EVERYONE BUT VERY STRICT WITH HERSELF.

I'm sorry. We just can't have sisters who aren't very strong.

FOR 13 YEARS SHE WAS THE HOUSE-KEEPER FOR HER BROTHER, A PRIEST.

THE BISHOP ASKED HER TO START AN ORDER OF TEACHING NUNS, AND AT FIRST SHE DIDN'T THINK SHE COULD.

But I'm not very healthy, your excellency!

BUT SHE DID WHAT SHE WAS ASKED ANYWAY. SHE TOOK THE NAME MARIE-ROSE AND WORKED VERY HARD TO TEACH AND RUN THE ORDER.

BLESSED MARIE-ROSE LIVED ONLY SIX MORE YEARS. SHE DID MUCH PENANCE AND WAS QUITE STRICT WITH THE OTHER SISTERS. THEY WERE POOR AND OFTEN PEOPLE SPOKE BADLY ABOUT THEM BUT SHE WOULD NOT GIVE UP HER WORK TO BRING CHILDREN TO GOD. SISTER MARIE-ROSE DIED WHEN SHE WAS 38.

You did a good job teaching today, Sister Anne.
