CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD - CGS is a program of Christian formation for children. Based on the teaching methods of Maria Montessori and drawing on the most essential elements of scripture and liturgy, CGS helps children to name, explore and deepen their relationship with God as the foundation for their lives. In CGS, the classroom, called the atrium, is a spiritual environment - a place of worship rather than a traditional classroom. It is a place of work that becomes prayer and conversation with God. We are pleased to again be offering Level One this year. Level One is for children ages 3 to 5 years old (preschool to kindergarten). The program will run every Saturday morning from 10:30 to Noon. The 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Some Musings

“You ask and do not receive because you ask wrongly.”

The persistence of children can be annoying at worst and laughable at best. I recall one of my sons asking me the same question over and over and when I asked him why he did that he simply said, “I thought you could change your mind.” I was not going to do that but I did admire his never failing hope that I just might change the answer from no to yes. He did change the way he asked, adding more ‘please Mommy’s’ to his request. I suppose he thought that if he finally asked the right question the answer would be more favourable. I’ve often thought that it’s not so much about asking rightly in prayer as it is in being willing to accept whatever answer we receive.

All too often when I pray for something, I end the prayer by informing the Lord just what I think He should do in answering it. It isn’t until I’m ready to accept His answer that I can be at peace. We need to have the faith of a little child, that He will answer and the answer will be in our best interests. Our Lord wants only good for us and we need to accept whatever the answer is and conform our thinking to His will. Perhaps that’s what Jesus means when He tells the disciples that they ask wrongly, by asking only and not accepting the answer so He warns them against asking wrongly.

Prayer is often difficult as we’re not quite sure what it is we’re asking. If we set our minds on doing His will, prayer becomes more natural and more open to His answer. Sometimes the answer is not the one we want to hear, so instead of accepting that answer we rail against it and find ourselves a-sea in an ocean of doubt and fear. Our God wants only good things for us and knowing that should make it easy to accept His will and work within those limits.

The sun is setting, a little earlier every day, and the nights are cooler. There’s a cooling of temperatures reminding me that fall is on its way. Soon, we’ll find ourselves with the brilliant colours of fall around us. Just as creation accepts the will of the Father, changing seasons, painting our world with vivid colours of yellow, orange and gold, let’s make sure we do the same; accepting His will for us and living with peace in His presence.
